1. Apologies for absence.

2. Minutes of the previous Ordinary Meeting.

A draft had been copied to all Councillors and displayed prior to the meeting. The meeting was agreed that the Minutes be adopted and the Chairman signed the Record Copy.

3. Declaration of Interest

There were no interests declared.

4. Matters Arising.

4.1. Village Pavements

The Clerk reconfirmed that the pavement between Tuckers Nook and Torpel way is to be resurfaced in this financial year. Cllr Purlant asked that the potholes in Barn Close be reported.

5. Planning

5.1. Outstanding Applications update

5.1.1. 45 High Street

No decision made to date, the Clerk to liaise with the Conservation Officer.

5.3.1. 2 Ladds Lane – Side Conservatory.

5.3.2. 14 Castle End –Barn Conversion to office. It was noted that the conditions for this permission included the provision of sufficient parking spaces.

## 6. Matters for Discussion

6.1. Traffic Calming.

6.1.1 PCC Survey. The Clerk confirmed that the survey had been carried out and that a proposal was urgently being prepared for the PCC cabinet. The Councillors expressed concern that the results were not divulged to MPC before being discussed. The Clerk was instructed to obtain the details.

The Clerk reported that he had been in contact with the police re speeding and that further discussions would be needed with PC Williams.

6.2. Village Hall.

Cllr Bagworth presented a copy of the 2005 accounts. It was agreed that they would be circulated to all councillors. Cllr Bagworth also confirmed that a caretaker had been appointed.

6.3. NHW.

Cllr Purllant reported on the Coordinator's Meeting. A major point that arose is that there appears to be little or no contact with South Lincs. Carol Aston agreed to investigate further.

The Clerk stated that the "Neighbourhood Street Brief" mobile police station would be in Maxey on May 2nd between 5.45pm and 6.30pm.

6.4. Casual Vacancies

It was noted that there will be three vacancies after the AGM in May. The Clerk agreed to post a notice to publicise the need for applicants and also to put a piece in the Tribune.

## 7. Correspondence.

7.1 Provision of Street Furniture. A letter had been received from PCC offering seats/benches in the area. It was agreed that a seat be requested for Barn Close play area and it was also agreed that the possibility of a seat in front of the Village Sign be discussed with PCC.

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8. Financial

8.1 Payment to Clerk re Expenses 2005/6. The expense claim was approved and a cheque signed for £143.97

8.2 Audit 2005/6. The Clerk will present the documents for approval at the May meeting.

8.3. A request for funding of an edition of the newsletter was approved. It was resolved that this would be a continuous annual commitment.

9.1 Paddocks. The suggestion that the development at 19 West End Rd should be named Orchard Grove rather than The Paddocks was agreed.

9.2 Bus Concessions. Complaints have been received about the new system which will be passed on to PCC.

9.3 Quarry. The Langdyke Trust will attempt to organise an event in the summer so that villagers can see how the restoration is progressing
