2. Minutes of the previous Ordinary Meeting.  
A draft had been copied to all Councillors and displayed prior to the meeting. The meeting was agreed that the Minutes be adopted and the Chairman signed the Record Copy.

4. Matters Arising.
  - 4.1. Traffic Management
    - 4.1.1. Give Way Signs and Markings. The meeting noted that the village had been remarked.
    - 4.1.2. Speed detectors. The Clerk advised the meeting that the speed detector scheme was being trialled in Cambridgeshire and would be eventually rolled out in to Peterborough in the New Year. Cllr Bagworth asked whether Cllr. Hiller had made any progress on the subject of illuminated signs. The Clerk was instructed to write to Cllr. Hiller asking for an update.
  - 4.2. Trees on High Street. The Clerk reported that he had asked for a budget quote for the removal of the trees but to date had not received a reply. The contractor advised that the adjacent power lines would greatly increase the cost. The Clerk was asked to apply for planning permission with approval of Anglian Water.
  - 4.3. Parked vehicles. The Clerk was instructed to write to the parties that have vehicles consistently parked on the street causing either nuisance or obstruction.
