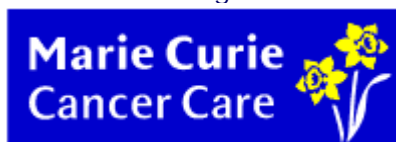
Good Turnout for Boxing Day Shoot

A crisp, bright cold morning greeted the intrepid Maxey Shooters who roused themselves from other festive attractions to bag a few clays on Boxing Day.

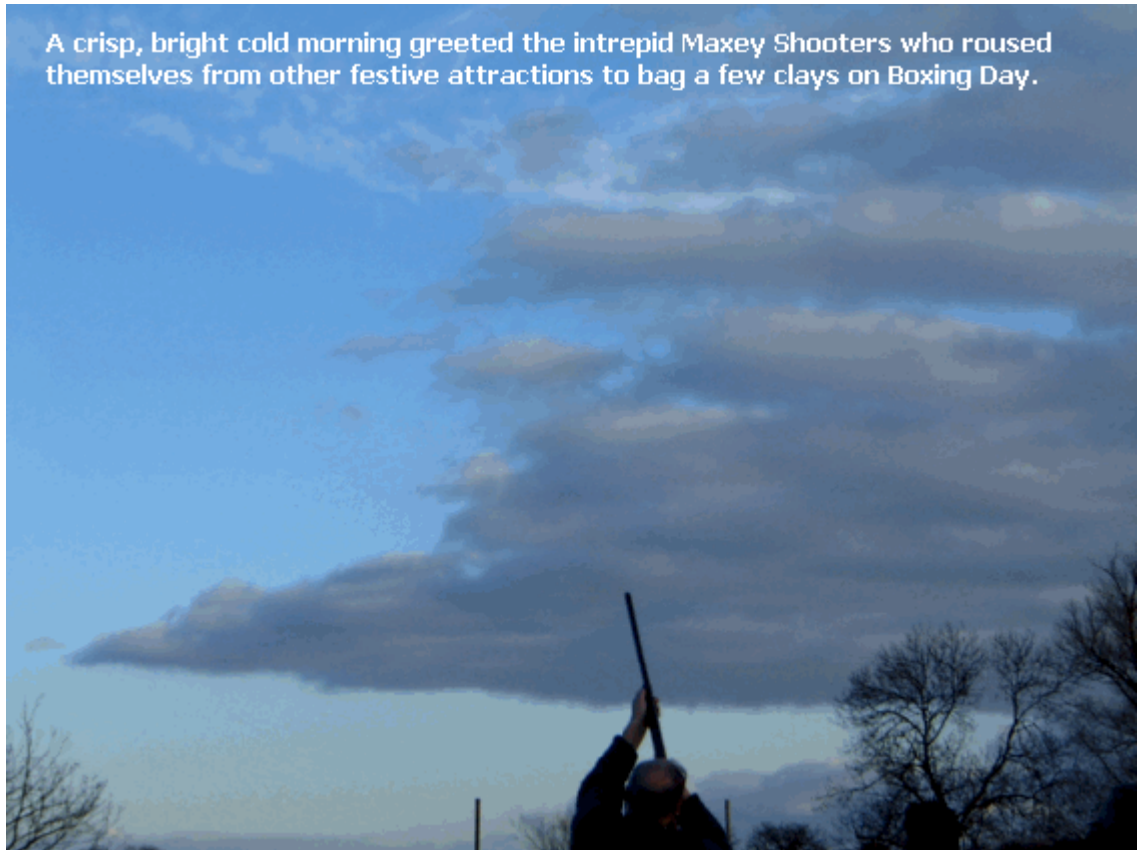
