A Short History

HD 3836 was first registered to Mr. Luthor Scott of Dewsbury on March 28th 1929. In 1932 the owner changed to Mr. Fredrick Hall of Bridlington who sold it 2 years later to Miss Gertrude Alice Peck.

Living at the same address, Miss Peck owned the car for 32 years, thus giving her name to the car. A large basket was fitted to the rear and the car was used to carry her goods around East Riding.

'Gertrude' was sold to Mr. Lovall of Driffield in 1966.

In 1972 she was rescued from a scrap yard for £250 by Mr. Robert Buttle of Bradford who completely restored her for trials work.

In 1984 she was sold to Mr Jack McKewen who trialed her for 5 years until Mr Gerry Savage of Stoke became her new owner in 1989.

In 1999 she was sold to the present owner, Mr Malcolm Barker of Ketton, Stamford, who also owns 2 other Jowetts, a Bradford Van & Lorry.
