The latest exhibition was held in Maxey Village Hall during the first weekend of August. This year there was a preview evening for invited guests on Friday before the doors were open for public viewing on Saturday and Sunday and was a very successful occasion. Judging from the many red stickers attached to a number of paintings the talent of our local artists remains as constant and as appreciated as ever and all members are to be congratulated on their quality of work in a range of mediums, and thanked for the fine display we all enjoyed. The group is looking for new membership and all enquiries are welcome.

The Maxey Art Group meets at Maxey Village Hall each Thursday between the hours of 9.30 am to noon. They do, however, take a break during the summer and then sometimes arrange to meet to paint outdoors (weather permitting). Activities resume in September.

The Group has been in existence for nearly 30 years - it stemmed from the class run for 25 years by Trevor Tanser - who retired in 2001. The artists so enjoyed being together that they decided to continue as a group - painting each week and encouraging each other, sharing new ideas and techniques and sometimes having a demonstration by guest artists

The Biennial Exhibition is enjoyed by all members who enthusiastically show the pictures they have been working on during the year. There is also usually a special display of work produced during or as a result of a demonstration - illustrating well the different interpretation that can be placed by each artist on a common theme.
