### Maxey's Fun Day Sizzles in the Sun

The village green was decked out in colourful stalls with a huge bouncy castle at the High Street end. In such sweltering weather it was great to see that numbers were well up on last year, especially for the participation events.

Organised by the [Maxey Blue Bell Charity Club](#) the day started with a 'Best Dressed Bike Parade' won by **Zoe Stott**.

While mums & dads made good use of the BBQ and quenched their thirst at the Hurdler Bar a number of other stalls like the Fudge Factory and the ice cream van were attracting a steady trade.

Before the kids races started up we had the first of two synchronised martial arts demonstrations from the 'Karate Kids', **Zack Rudman, Jordan Whitehead & James Thompson** (check out their [mini-movie](#)).

MC Michael Stott kept everything moving along at a good pace and everyone in line with his loud hailer. Soon the kids races were underway. The foot races had several categories including: 12 years and under (winner **Omar Talab**); 8 years and under (winner **James Crayford**); 4 years and under (winner **Chloe Nash** - see [mini-movie](#)) and open/adults (winner Sam Garford).

The Egg & Spoon races were next: 4 years and under (winner Joseph Neill); 8 years and under (winner Charlotte Brewer) & 12 years and under (winner Elenor Watson).

The sack races were probably the most competitive with some fine performances: 4 years and under (winner **James Crayford**); 8 years and under (winner **Charlotte Brewer**), 12 years and under (winner **Jordan Walker** - see mini-movie) and open/adults (winner **Gary Hodgkins**).

There was still more to come with the ever popular tug 'o war (boys vs girls, up hill vs down hill, rope tied to climbing frame, it was all there!) as well as some new events like Bobbing for Apples and the Welly Water Race.

A popular stand was the water gun stall - great to get even with someone and great to cool down if on the receiving end. Various car boot & plant stalls quietly went about their business during the day while the bouncy castle remained a popular distraction for many. Sitting down in the shade won the day for many adults.
