## Village Hit by Graffiti Vandals

### Village Hall, Driveway Gates & Shaw's Coaches Targeted

In the early hours of Saturday 14 April 2007 a number of locations in Maxey were the targets of graffiti 'artists'.

White driveway gates in West End Road, two walls of the Village Hall and at least one windscreen of a Shaw's coach were spray painted with typical graffiti style writing including the wording 'CANT BEAT ME'.

At approximately 3.00 am four youths dressed with 'hoodies' and one wearing a balaclava were spotted by witnesses coming across the fields at the back of the coach parking area towards Woodgate Lane.

They claimed to be travelling to Werrington from Market Deeping and were 'lost'. All details to hand including copies of the photographs on this page have been passed to the Maxey Neighbourhood Watch and our local PC Dave Williams.
